THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION

The Village of Mt. Zion is a community that is proud of the services that are offered to its residents. The community is served by the Mayor, the Village Board of Trustees, Administrative Department, Police Department, Public Works Department, Parks & Recreation Department, and the Mt. Zion Convention Center.

- The Village Board consists of the Mayor and six trustee positions. These elected positions are fouryear terms, alternating every two years.
- · The Administrative Department consists of the Village Administrator, Village Treasurer, Village Clerk, and support staff who assist residents with building permits, zoning and land issues, water/sewer bill payments, and much more.
- · The Police Department services include patrols, investigations, traffic enforcement, animal control, KICK, school resource officer, neighborhood watch, bike patrols, vacation checks, and much more.
- The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance of the Village's infrastructure, which includes streets, water, sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and park maintenance.
- The Parks & Recreation Department is responsible for all current and future park and trail development and also provides year-round recreational programs for both children and adults.
- · The Mt. Zion Convention Center, which was constructed in 2011, is home to many public and private events for the community. It boasts over 11,000 square feet of space, that can be divided into three rooms for different events.

For recreation, enjoy several of Mt. Zion's beautiful, scenic parks, including Spitler Woods State Park (202 acres), Fletcher Park (23 acres), and many residential pocket parks. Mt. Zion has miles of walking trails to hike or ride bikes. Fletcher Park features an extra-large playground, multi-acre fishing pond and boardwalk, amphitheater; large, open pavilionwith restrooms, recreation center, six tennis courts, walking trails, and open areas. Fletcher Park has many public and private events each year.

RECREATIONAL & CULTURAL ATTRACTIONS:

Spitler Woods State Park: 202.5 acre State Park with pavilions, playgrounds, wooded trails and openplay.

Fletcher Park: 24 acre Community Park with pavilions, playground, walking trail, tennis courts, 2.5 acre catch and release pond, indoor recreation center, and amphitheater.

Goodwin Park: 10 acre Neighborhood Park with a recreational baseball and soccer field, pavilion and playground. Mt. Zion Trail goes through this park.

Heritage and Lions Parks: small Neighborhood Parks with playground equipment.

Mt. Zion Trail: 2.7 miles of bike/walking trail that extends from the east to the west across the Village.
