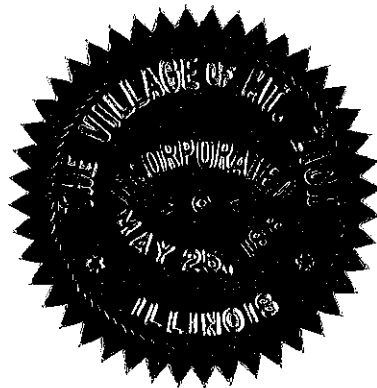

ORDINANCE 2017-17

ORDINANCE SETTING CURRENT PREVAILING WAGE  
RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION

WHEREAS, the state of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City, or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, codified as amend, 820 ILCS 130/1 et. Seq. (1993), formerly Ill. Rev. State., Ch. 48, par. 39s-1 seq., and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Village of Mt. Zion of Macon County investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the construction of public works, for said Village of Mt. Zion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by State, County, City, or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amend, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Mt. Zion is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Macon County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June 5, 2017 (or as updated by the State of Illinois), a copy of that determination being attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Village of Mt. Zion. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village of Mt. Zion to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The Village of Mt. Zion shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village of Mt. Zion this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wages. A copy of this determination or of the current determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

SECTION 4: The Village of Mt. Zion shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be effected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The Village of Mt. Zion shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The Village of Mt. Zion shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after is passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
