VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES December 16, 2024 5:15 p.m.

Mayor Williams called the Meeting of the Mt. Zion Village Board of Trustees to order at 5:15 p.m. in the Village Hall Board Room. The following Board Members were present for roll call: Randy Doty, Chris Siudyla, and Wendy Kernen. Also present were Village Administrator, Julie Miller, Director of Public Works, Chad Reynolds, Chief of Police, Adam Skundberg, Parks and Recreation Director, Tiffany Wilson, Event Coordinator, Tiffany Streibich, Village Treasurer, Corey McKenzie, and Village Clerk, Dawn Reynolds. Donna Scales, Nate Patrick, and Phil Tibbs were absent.

Pledge of Allegiance

<u>Public Hearing – Proposed 2024 Tax Levy</u>: A motion to open the Public Hearing was made by Trustee Siudyla, seconded by Trustee Kernan. A voice vote was unanimous; motion carried.

Mayor Williams asked for public comment on the Proposed 2024 Tax Levy. No one wished to speak at the Public Hearing. Administrator Miller announced that no written or verbal comments were received from the public.

A motion to close the Public Hearing was made by Trustee Kernan, seconded by Trustee Doty. A voice vote was unanimous; motion carried.

<u>Public Hearing – Proposed FY 2025 Budget</u>: A motion to open the Public Hearing was made by Trustee Siudyla, seconded by Trustee Kernan. A voice vote was unanimous; motion carried.

Mayor Williams asked for public comment on the FY 2025 Budget. No one wished to speak at the Public Hearing. Administrator Miller announced that no written or verbal comments were received from the public.

A motion to close the Public Hearing was made by Trustee Siudyla, seconded by Trustee Doty. A voice vote was unanimous; motion carried.

Public Forum: Two (2) people were present. No one wished to address the Board at this time.

Consent Agenda: A motion was made by Trustee Kernan to approve the Consent Agenda as presented, seconded by Trustee Doty. A breakdown of Fund Warrants for the period ending December 16, 2024 is as follows: General Fund - \$272,043.24, Motor Fuel Tax - \$31,191.11, BDD - \$27,705.00, Rt. 121 TIF District II - \$10,000.00, 2024 G.O. Capital Project - \$6,345.00, Water Revenue Fund - \$107,440.72, and Sewer Revenue Fund - \$77,156.23. A roll call vote was taken: Doty-yea, Siudyla-yea, Kernan-yea, and Mayor Williams-yea. Motion carried 4-yea, 0-nay, 3-absent.

Consideration and action on the Village of Mt. Zion 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan FY 2025-2029: Administrator Miller presented the 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan 2025-2029 for approval. FY 2025 includes all projects presented at the previous Board meeting. Years 2026-2029 contain projects on the horizon but are subject to change as needs and resources change. All FY 2025 projects have been included in the budget.

A motion was made by Trustee Doty to approve the Village of Mt. Zion 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan FY 2025-2029 as presented, seconded by Trustee Siudyla. A roll call vote was taken: Doty-yea, Siudyla-yea, Kernan-yea, and Mayor Williams-yea. Motion carried 4-yea, 0-nay, 3-absent.

Consideration and action on Ordinance No. 2024-29 An Ordinance Establishing a Municipal Budget Pursuant to Chapter 24, Section 8-2-9.1 of the Illinois Revised Statutes for the FY Beginning January 1, 2025 and Ending December 31, 2025: Administrator Miller presented the FY 2025 Budget for approval. A copy of the proposed budget has been available for public comment at Village Hall as well as the Village's website. The Public Hearing was published in the newspaper. No written or verbal comments were received from the public. The budget must be approved and filed with the Macon County Clerk's office.

A motion was made by Trustee Siudyla to approve the Ordinance Establishing a Municipal Budget Pursuant to Chapter 24, Section 8-2-9.1 of the Illinois Revised Statutes for the FY Beginning January 1, 2025 and Ending December 31, 2025 as presented, seconded by Trustee Kernan. A roll call vote was taken: Doty-yea, Siudyla-yea, Kernan-yea, and Mayor Williams-yea. Motion carried 4-yea, 0-nay, 3-absent.

Consideration and action on Ordinance No. 2024-30 An Ordinance Establishing Salary Ranges for All Full-Time Employees and Elected Officials of the Village of Mt. Zion and Repealing Ordinance 2023-19: Administrator Miller presented the salary ranges for all full-time employees for approval.

A motion was made by Trustee Kernan to approve the FY 2025 Salaries and the Ordinance Establishing Salary Ranges for All Full-Time Employees of the Village of Mt. Zion and Repealing Ordinance 2023-19 as presented, seconded by Trustee Doty. A roll call vote was taken: Doty-yea, Siudyla-yea, Kernan-yea, and Mayor Williams-yea. Motion carried 4-yea, 0-nay, 3-absent.

Consideration and action on Ordinance No. 2024-31 Annual Tax Levy Ordinance for the Village of Mt. Zion, Illinois: Administrator Miller presented the annual tax levy for approval. The 2024 Tax Levy Ordinance reflects a slight increase in the funds requested due to growth within the Village. Even with the increase, if the estimated EAV is accurate the actual tax rate should be lower than last year.

No written or verbal comments were received by the public. The ordinance must be approved and filed with the Macon County Clerk's office.

A motion was made by Trustee Doty to approve the Annual Tax Levy Ordinance for 2024 as presented, seconded by Trustee Siudyla. A roll call vote was taken: Doty-yea, Siudyla-yea, Kernan-yea, and Mayor Williams-yea. Motion carried 4-yea, 0-nay, 3-absent.

Consideration and action on Ordinance No. 2024-32 An Ordinance Abating the Tax Heretofore Levied for the Year to Pay Debt Service on \$2,166,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternative Revenue Source) of the Village of Mt. Zion, Macon County, Illinois: Administrator Miller presented an ordinance abating the property tax levy to repay the \$2,166,000 G.O. Bonds for 2024 for approval. The bonds were a refinance of bonds originally issued in March of 2009 for Fletcher Park. The Village pledged utility tax revenues as the source for the repayment of the bonds. The ordinance must be approved and filed with the Macon County Clerk's office.

A motion was made by Trustee Siudyla to approve the Ordinance Abating the Tax Levy for the Debt Service on \$2,166,000 in General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) for Tax Year 2024 as presented, seconded by Trustee Kernan. A roll call vote was taken: Doty-yea, Siudyla-yea, Kernan-yea, and Mayor Williams-yea. Motion carried 4-yea, 0-nay, 3-absent.

Administrator & Staff Items:

Clerk Reynolds informed the Board that they will receive an email of the 2025 Holiday & Meeting schedule.

Treasurer McKenzie reported the Sale of Surplus total of \$6,597.00.

Coordinator Streibich invited the Board to the Mardi Gras Casino Night on February 15th.

Director Wilson shared the Village Christmas events.

Director Reynolds reported the Vollmer buildings have been demolished and a snow fence will be installed to keep the property closed off.

Administrator Miller informed the Board of meetings she will be attending for the Mt. Zion Park Foundation Board and Macon County Rural Transportation Board.

Mayor & Trustee Items:

Trustee Doty gave kudos to Public Works for a job well done on the demolition and asked for replacement of the bike trail sign on Baltimore and Main Street. Doty also thanked everyone for what they do.

<u>Adjournment</u>: A motion was made by Trustee Siudyla to adjourn the December 16, 2024 Village Board meeting, seconded by Trustee Kernan. A voice vote was unanimous; motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:35 p.m.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2021, the Village of Mt. Zion, Macon County, Illinois (the "Village") by its duly elected President and Village Board of Trustees and pursuant to 65 Illinois Compiled Statutes Section 5/11-74.4 et. seq. (the "TIF Act") heretofore adopted a Redevelopment Plan and Projects; designated a Redevelopment Project Area; and adopted Tax Increment Allocation Financing for the Mt. Zion Route 121 Tax Increment Financing (TIF) District II (the "TIF District"); and

WHEREAS, on the November 16, 2020, the Village by its duly elected President and Village Board of Trustees and pursuant to the TIF Act approved and Authorized the Execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement with Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3, the County of Macon, Richland Community College #537, Mt. Zion Township, Mt. Zion Fire Protection District, Mt. Zion Library District, Macon County Conservation District, Decatur Sanitary District, Macon County Health and Mental Health Board, and the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois on behalf of Macon County Cooperative Extension (collectively the "Taxing Districts") by Ordinance No. 2020-22 for the Mt. Zion Route 121 TIF District II; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Intergovernmental Agreement with the Taxing Districts, the Village Treasurer has determined and reported that as of December 31, 2024, the Village has received \$327,082.39, excluding interest, in total real estate tax distributions from the Macon County Treasurer for real estate tax increment generated by the TIF District in tax year 2023 payable 2024 (Exhibit 1); and

WHEREAS, the Village Treasurer has determined and reported that as of December 31, 2024, the Mt. Zion Route 121 Special Tax Allocation Fund includes a surplus of \$123,919.97, which represents seventy-five percent (75%) of the tax year 2023 payable 2024 real estate tax increment generated by the "Pre-existing Single-Family Residential Properties", as defined in the Intergovernmental Agreement and ten percent (10%) of the tax year 2023 payable 2024 real estate tax increment for all other properties in the TIF District, which surplus amount may be paid to the Macon County Treasurer for distribution to taxing districts in the Redevelopment Project Area in accordance with the provisions of the TIF Act as shown in Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, the President and Village Board of Trustees of the Village hereby find and determine that it is appropriate to declare surplus in the amount of \$123,919.97 and to cause that surplus to be distributed by the County Treasurer to the taxing districts as provided in the TIF Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

- 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.
- 2. The President and Village Board of Trustees, pursuant to Sections 4-7 and 4-9 of the TIF Act and other applicable authority, hereby declare a surplus of funds in the Special Tax Allocation Fund in the amount of \$123,919.97 to be distributed by the Macon County Treasurer to all the taxing districts in the Redevelopment Project Area as shown in Exhibit 2.
- 3. The Village Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay such funds from the Special Tax Allocation Fund in the amount of \$123,919.97 to the Macon County Treasurer for distribution to the taxing districts in the Redevelopment Project Area in accordance with the provisions of the TIF Act. Payment by the Village Treasurer shall be made after approval of this Ordinance, but not more than 180 days after the close of the Village's Fiscal Year 2024. The Village Treasurer also is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Macon County Treasurer.
- 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law and shall take effect upon its passage as required by law.

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PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED by the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Mt. Zion, Macon County, Illinois, on the 21st day of January, A.D., 2025, and deposited and filed in the Office of the Village Clerk of said Village on that date.

WHEREAS, corporate authorities desire to increase the Water Fund Health/Life/Dental, R/M Building, R/M Equipment, R/M System, Engineering, Contractual Services, Dues and Subscriptions, Utilities, Water Purchases, and Meters line items by \$14,720 and increase the funds appropriated by Ordinance 2023-18, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That total expenditures appropriated for the Water Fund will be increased from \$1,888,000 to \$1,902,720 for Fiscal Year 2024.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 2023-18 is hereby amended.

Attached is a resolution authorizing the Mayor or the Village Administrator to sign and execute the contract with the lowest responsible bidder to aggregate the residential and small commercial retail electric loads located within the Village. Due to the nature of the bidding process, and the daily changing of electrical prices, it could potentially limit the Village on the pricing it could obtain. The Stone River Group will negotiate a price on our behalf and make a recommendation. At that time, the Mayor or the Village Administrator and the Clerk will have to sign the agreement and have it submitted within the applicable time limit.

The Village Board has passed this same resolution with The Stone River Group in the past.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY FOR RESIDENTIAL AND SMALL COMMERCIAL RETAIL CUSTOMERS WHO DO NOT OPT OUT OF SUCH A PROGRAM (MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC AGGREGATION)

WHEREAS, Section 1-92 of the Illinois Power Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3855/1-92, permits a municipality, if authorized by referendum, to adopt an ordinance by which it may operate a program to solicit bids and enter into service agreements for the sale and purchase of electricity and related services and equipment to residential and small commercial customers who do not opt-out of such a program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mt. Zion ("Village"), in a referendum held on November 6, 2014, submitted the public question of whether it should operate the program as an opt-out program; and

WHEREAS, the referendum passed by a majority vote of the qualified electors voting on the question; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that the best interests of the Village are served by entering into an agreement with the lowest responsible bidder, pursuant to 20 ILCS 3855/1-92, to aggregate the residential and small commercial retail electric loads located within the Village and to arrange for competitive electric supply to these retail electrical accounts; and

WHEREAS, because electricity is a commodity for which supply bids typically are made each morning and expire the same day at the close of business, the Village must act promptly to accept any such desired bid in order to contractually guarantee a per kilowatt hour electric rate for its residential and small commercial customers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Mayor of the Village of Mt. Zion, Illinois or the Administrator of the Village of Mt. Zion, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to execute and deliver and the Village Clerk of the Village of Mt. Zion, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to attest to said execution of a service agreement with the lowest responsible bidder for the supply of electricity for residential and small commercial retail customers who do not opt out of such a program, said execution and attestation to take place within the applicable time constraints required by the bidder; provided, however, that the energy price to be paid per kilowatt hour pursuant to the agreement is less than the default rate currently in effect, resulting in savings for the Village's residential and small commercial retail customers.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until such time as the year 2025 electricity aggregation program electric supplier selection process has been completed.

Presented for consideration is an ordinance amending the chapter and section pertaining to snow emergencies. The purpose of the amendment is to clearly define the penalty for not removing a car from the street when a snow emergency is declared and to establish the fine at \$100.00 rather than a normal parking ticket of \$25.00.

During the last major storm, many residents ignored the snow emergency declaration and at least 2 vehicles were towed. Vehicles parked on the street, especially on cul da sacs, create a dangerous situation for the Village's snow plow drivers and put the Village at risk for a liability insurance claim if the vehicle is damaged.

Snow Emergencies are declared by the Village Administrator and are sent to the media via a press release, sent out through our emergency notification system, placed on social media and the Village's website.

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 32, SEC 32-97 OF THE MT. ZION CODE OF ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mt. Zion, Illinois has determined that the it is the best interest of the general public's health and well-being to regulate parking of any vehicles on any or all of the Village streets during snow emergencies.

WHEREAS, Section 32-97 of the Mt. Zion Code of Ordinances defines "snow emergencies" and establishes parking rules and regulations during said emergencies.

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of the general public that Section 32-97(e) be added to the Mt. Zion Code of Ordinances to clarify the fines and penalties that may be enforced for violations of Section 32-97 and its subparagraphs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. Recitals. The preliminary paragraphs set forth above are incorporated herein as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Amendment of Sec. 32-97.</u> "Chapter 32, Section 32-97. Snow emergencies" of the Village of Mt. Zion Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended such that subparagraph (e) is hereby added to the Section as follows:

(e) Penalties. Any person who violates the parking rules and provisions of this Section 32-97 shall be fined \$100.00 and issued an appropriate citation by the Village police department for each offense. Failure to pay said fine within 14 days of receipt will result in the fine amount being increased to \$200.00. Separate citations may be issued for each day the violation continues. The person listed on the vehicle's registration shall be considered in control of the vehicle at the time it was parked. In addition to the fine described above, the Village police department shall be authorized to immediately tow and impound any vehicle found to be in violation of the parking rules and provisions of this Section 32-97 at the sole cost of the person listed on the vehicle's registration.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordnance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval according to law.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS DECEMBER 2024

- AGGRAVATED DUI- On the 7th Officers were detailed to a convenience store in the 900 block
 of State Hwy 121 to investigate a possible medical issue. On arrival officers found a 40 year
 old male passed out at the wheel of his vehicle. The vehicle was running. As officers spoke
 to the driver who acted confused and was unable to answer basic questions. After EMS and
 Mt. Zion Fire examined the suspect and found no medical issues, officers attempted to
 administer field sobriety tests, however the driver refused. The driver was arrested on
 suspicion of DUI. After officers confirmed the driver had a previous DUI conviction he was
 cited for Aggravated DUI and released.
- AGGRAVATED BATTERY- On the 28th officers were detailed to a residence off of Burgener Drive regarding a fight in progress. On arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 44 year old male. Officers noticed the victim had extensive facial injuries. The victim stated he was involved in a verbal altercation with the suspect, his 43 year old neighbor, over his dog running loose. The victim stated the suspect struck him without warning and he fell to the ground. The suspect then struck him in the face numerous times as he laid in the street. A witness advised officers he heard yelling, looked out his window, and observed the suspect strike the victim in the face several times. The witness stated the victim only attempted to cover his face and did not attempt to fight back. EMS personnel on scene advised injuries to the victim were serious enough that the victim's vision would likely be affected. The suspect was arrested and transported to the Macon County Jail on the pending charge of Aggravated Battery.
