Minutes

The MTZ Board of Police Commissioners met on October 12, 2016. In attendance were Police Commissioners David Beasley, Bob Kistenfeger, and John Anderson, and Police Chief Adam Skundberg. Police Sergeant Jim Stevens attended the entire session with Police Lieutenant arriving approximately 10 minutes into the session.

The meeting began at 6:50 PM and concluded at 7:42 PM.

Public Forum: No comments offered.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes from July 13, 2016 were reviewed and accepted.

New Business: None

Executive Closed Session: Motion made by Commissioner Anderson to move into Closed Session, seconded by Commissioner Kistenfeger, all voted in favor.

The purpose of the closed session was to discuss references and background check information of applicants on the current eligibility list. The Closed Session was recorded in its entirety.

Other: Commissioner Kistenfeger will request review by the village attorney of Chapter

III, Section 9(e) of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Police Commissioners Village of Mt. Zion, having an effective date of January 6, 2014, 1st revision dated September 10, 2014. Specifically, does the 2nd sentence allow the Commission to appoint an applicant who has successfully completed the required law enforcement training referenced in the section, but is not one of the top 10 on the current eligibility list? For example, the current eligibility list includes 10 applicants, but there were more applicants than those 10. Would the Commission be in violation of our Rules and Regs if - for example- applicant ranked number 15 (who has the required police training) but is not on the current eligibility list, is appointed by the Police Commission to the next open police officer vacancy? It has been suggested that the 'notwithstanding' clause permits the Police Commission to make such an appointment.
