Meeting Minutes

Minutes

The MTZ Board of Police Commissioners met on July 12, 2017. In attendance were Police Commissioners David Beasley, Bob Kistenfeger, and John Anderson as well as Police Chief Adam Skundberg. Lieutenant Mike Foster also attended.

The meeting began at 7:00 PM and concluded at 7:52 PM.

Public Forum: No comments offered.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes from April 12, 2017 were reviewed and accepted.

Old Business: Discussed testing pass criteria/threshold for the written tests. In the past the threshold was set at 70 percent or greater for the average of all the written tests. Of question, do we desire to change the threshold such that each category of the written test had to be 70 percent or greater? After some discussion, Commissioner Beasley made the motion to keep the threshold as done in the past; that being, the average of all the written tests must be 70 percent or greater. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted yes; thereby keeping the threshold the same.

New Business:

Application Process: Time to send a notice to the public that a new Eligibility list will be required and a new Orientation date needs to be set.

Discussed September 16, 2017 as the Orientation Date with October 21, 2017 as the possible date for the Oral exams.

A minimum of two Commissioners need to be present for the Orientation.

Executive Closed Session: None

Police Report:

Macon County Sheriff's office has started their process to hire additional deputies. It's possible one or more of the Mount Zion officers will apply for the Macon County position.

Commissioner Beasley motioned that we move to closed session to discuss the background information of the current candidates on the existing eligibility list. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion and all voted in favor so motion carried.

Closed session started at approximately 7:30 and ended at 7:51. The closed session discussion was taped in its entirety.

Since none of the current officers of the Mount Zion Police department have officially turned in their resignation at time of this meeting, an opening does not officially exist; therefore no further action required of the Commission at this time.
