Meeting Minutes

Mount Zion Board of Police Commissioners Meeting

Minutes

The MTZ Board of Police Commissioners met on October 10, 2018. In attendance were Police Commissioners David Beasley, Bob Kistenfeger, and Jennifer Harris. Police Chief Adam Skundberg was also present.

The meeting began at 7:00 PM and concluded at 8:14 PM.

Public Forum: No comments offered.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes from July 11, 2018 were reviewed and accepted.

Old Business: The Commissions continued discussions regarding changes to the Rules and Regulations. Areas discussed included:

1) Chapter III, section 4 (Examinations).

Discussed appropriateness of 60/40 weighting of written/oral tests. Decided to keep the weights at 60% written and 40% oral.

Discussed appropriateness of 70% minimum passing grade on a CUMULATIVE basis. Decided a minimum passing grade of 70% cumulative was appropriate.

2) Chapter III, section 5 (Physical Aptitude Test).

Discussed the addition of the following paragraph:

All applicants, as a condition of employment, may be required to submit themselves to the Peace Officer Wellness Evaluation Report (P.O.W.E.R. test). In the event such test is administered, only candidates who successfully complete the Peace Officer Wellness Evaluation Report (Power Test) will be eligible for appointment.

Commissioner Beasley motioned to approve the wording, seconded by Commissioner Harris. All voted in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

3) Next steps for rewrite of the Rules and Regulations

Commissioner Beasley will publish a clean version of a draft of the Rules and Regulations with the latest changes and send to those in attendance. The Commissioners will review the draft and discuss at the next board meeting.

4) Commissioner Kistenfeger term/expiration.

Commissioner Kistenfeger's 3 year term expires in December 2018. The Village Board will discuss the continuation of service at one of the upcoming Village Board meetings.2
